



Contribution to the Sustainable Development Goals



1. SDGs as a Framework for FCCenviro's Contribution

The Sustainable Development Goals provide a global roadmap for advancing a more equitable, inclusive, and environmentally responsible development model. Adopted by the United Nations as part of the 2030 Agenda, the 17 SDGs address today's most pressing social, environmental, and economic challenges and require the active engagement of businesses, governments, and society to translate global commitments into tangible actions and measurable outcomes.

FCCenviro's Sustainability Strategy 2026–2030 is aligned with the 2030 Agenda and translates its contribution to the Sustainable Development Goals into commitments, actions, and KPIs directly linked to its role as a provider of essential environmental services. This contribution is not conceived as a purely declarative exercise, but rather as a direct outcome of the company's activities in waste management, circular economy, decarbonisation, people protection, innovation, and good governance.

1. SDGs as a Framework for FCCenviro's Contribution

FCCenviro contributes to the SDGs through its core business: waste management, recycling, energy recovery, urban cleaning, public space maintenance, soil remediation, and other essential environmental services.

The 2026–2030 Sustainability Strategy is built on a double materiality assessment, enabling the company to prioritise the impacts, risks, and opportunities that are most relevant to both the organisation and its stakeholders.

FCCenviro prioritises those SDGs where it can deliver the most direct, measurable, and operationally relevant contribution.

The SDGs are embedded across FCCenviro's five strategic pillars:

- SL1. Climate Change and Pollution Prevention
- SL2. Resource Use & Circular Economy
- SL3. Own Workforce
- SL4. Business Conduct
- SL5. Innovation



2. Environmental Contribution

FCCenviro’s primary environmental contribution focuses on emissions reduction, the energy transition, waste recovery, landfill diversion, and ecosystem protection, with a particularly significant impact on SDGs related to clean energy, sustainable cities, responsible consumption and production, climate action, and life on land.



The company supports the energy transition through the generation of energy from non-recyclable waste at Energy-from-Waste (EfW) facilities, the energy recovery of biogas, and the increased use of renewable electricity.



Through essential services such as waste collection, urban cleaning, recycling, green space maintenance, and efficient resource management, FCCenviro contributes to cleaner, more resilient, and healthier cities.



FCCenviro strengthens the circular economy by increasing the recovery of its own non-hazardous waste, reducing the impacts of final disposal, and advancing the integration of sustainability criteria into supplier management, including targets for the assessment of procurement under sustainable sourcing criteria.



FCCenviro advances its decarbonisation roadmap through the reduction of emissions intensity, the progressive electrification of its fleet, increased use of renewable electricity, and enhanced biogas capture at landfill sites.



The company implements initiatives focused on environmental restoration, responsible land management, reducing impacts associated with landfill operations, and protecting biodiversity in areas surrounding its activities.

3. Social Contribution

FCCenviro’s strategy recognises people as a fundamental pillar of sustainable business. Its social contribution is reflected in improvements to occupational health and safety, professional development, equal opportunities, inclusion, and employment stability.



FCCenviro contributes to public health by reducing air, water, and soil pollution, while strengthening its prevention culture and occupational health and safety practices. The strategy establishes specific targets to reduce both accident frequency and severity, including a planned reduction in the Lost Time Injury Frequency Rate from 23.29 to 18.99 by 2030.



FCCenviro promotes inclusive policies, equality action plans, work-life balance measures, the development of female leadership, and initiatives aimed at increasing the representation of women in leadership and management positions.



The company fosters stable employment, training, internal and international mobility, professional development, and an enhanced employee experience. By 2030, targets include achieving an 80% employee satisfaction score in the workplace climate survey and increasing training in strategic areas.



The strategy includes objectives related to diversity, equity and inclusion, dedicated training in these areas, and the integration of people with disabilities and other vulnerable groups into the workforce.

4. Governance, Ethics, Innovation and Partnerships to Accelerate the SDGs

FCCenviro’s contribution to the SDGs is underpinned by a governance model that enables the monitoring of commitments, the correction of deviations, and the reinforcement of transparency. Business ethics, innovation, and stakeholder collaboration act as cross-cutting enablers that accelerate the impact of the strategy.



Innovation and digitalisation are positioned as key tools to modernise infrastructure, optimise processes, improve operational efficiency, reduce environmental impacts, and strengthen the company’s resilience to emerging regulatory, technological, and climate-related challenges.



FCCenviro reinforces ethics, transparency, and regulatory compliance through the expansion of its compliance model, training on the Code of Ethics, and the assessment of compliance risks. The strategy establishes the objective of achieving 100% coverage of entities under the compliance framework and 100% Code of Ethics training for both online and offline employees by 2030.



The company maintains dialogue channels with employees, customers, public authorities, suppliers, communities, industry associations, and investors, reinforcing collaboration as a key driver for advancing sustainability.
